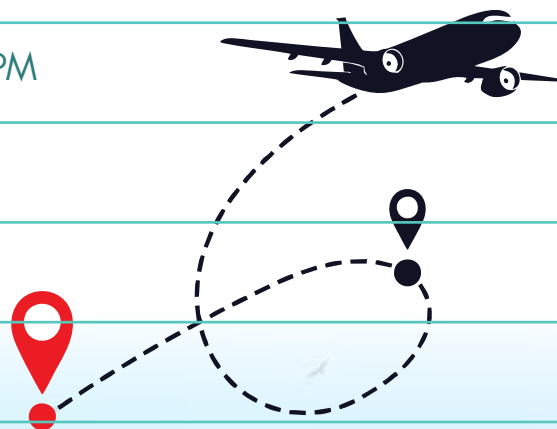

Places Around Raipur

BARNAWAPARA WILDLIFE SANCTUARY : (ONE DAY TOUR)

Barnawapara Wildlife sanctuary, is named after Bar and Nawapara forest villages, which are in the heart of the sanctuary. It is a land mass of undulating terrain dotted with numerous low and high hillocks well forested area. This sanctuary is famous for the frequent sighting of the Indian bison (Gaur) Cheetal, Sambhar, Neelgai, Wild boar are commonly seen. It boasts of over 150 species Birds. You need to wake up early in the morning to get ready for a safari drive at Barnawapara wildlife sanctuary in the company of experienced park guides and try your luck to witness the tigers in the wilderness. In addition to tigers, there is a lot more to see in Barnawapara safari like rare Swamp Deer, Sambar, Spotted Deer, Indian Gaur, Bear etc.



HOW TO REACH BARNAWAPARA WILDLIFE SANCTUARY :

This richly vegetated unique wildlife sanctuary is 120 Kms away from Raipur. The place is easily approachable through the PWD forest road, which connects Barnawapara with Raipur via on NH 53.

SIRPUR : (HALF DAY TOUR)

Sirpur is a small village located in the state of Chhattisgarh, situated on the banks of river Mahanadi. The village of Sirpur is an archaeological wonder. Inspiration to many architects, this village is rich in its temple culture. A quaint hidden gem, it has a deep

connection to the Buddhism world and a treasure for archaeological findings from the 8th century. There are numerous temples one can visit, and is generally a hub for passionate historians. A look at the historical artefacts and the deep carvings on the walls of the temples have inspired many architects around the world. Lakshman Temple, Baleshwar Temple, Rama Temple, Buddha Vihara, Teevardev are the main places to visit.



HOW TO REACH SIRPUR :

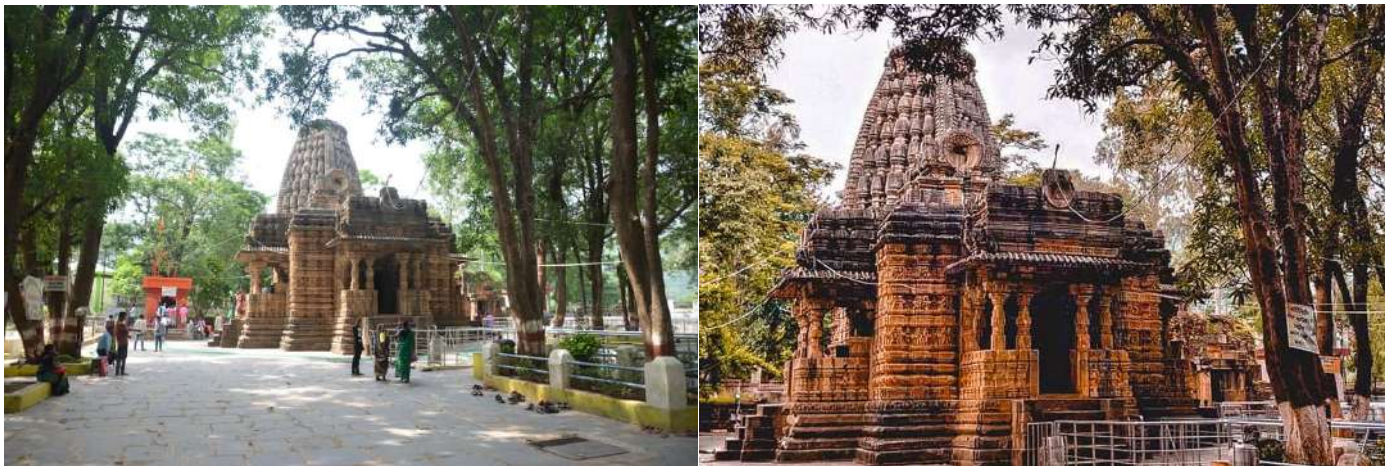
Sirpur is 78 km away from Raipur (1 hour and 30 minutes journey). To reach the city, you can drive by car or book a cab from Raipur. Sirpur is very accessible due to the four-lane national highway and bus services available.



BHORAMDEV : (ONE DAY TOUR)

The Bhoramdeo Temple bears a striking resemblance to the Sun Temple of Konark and is believed to have been constructed during the 7th to 12th century. It is popularly known as the Khajuraho of Chhattisgarh. It is the main temple among the bunch of four ancient temples in this region - Madwa Mahal, Istaliq Temple, Cherki Mahal and Bhoramdeo temple - and stands

as strong as ever in the Kabirdham district. This temple is dedicated to Lord Shiva. The outstanding Nagar style of architecture and the intricately carved images are a spectacular work of art. The Boramdeo Temple features admirably sculpted images of the ten avatars of Lord Vishnu, in addition to the images of Lord Shiva and Lord Ganesha. Pilgrims often stay back to savour the outstanding views that the temple has to offer, after seeking their blessings.



HOW TO REACH BHORAMDEV :

The Boramdeo Temple is located at the banks of a man-made lake, at the foot of the Maikal range of hills. It is situated about 18 km in the northwest direction of the Tehsil town of Karwadha, Kabirdham district. Kawardha is well connected to Raipur via road and the distance from Raipur to Boramdev is 135 kms.



JAGDALPUR : (TWO DAYS TOUR)

Jagdalpur is a beautiful city in the Bastar district of Chhattisgarh and is one of the most popular tourist destinations in the state. Jagdalpur has a rich history of political activism and has developed a very rich culture over time. From national parks, waterfalls, palaces and museums to natural caves and religious sites, there are

many tourist delights in this place. Chitrakote Falls, Tirathgarh waterfall, Kutumsar Caves, Kanger Valley National Park, Danteshwari Temple are the famous tourist attractions.



HOW TO REACH JAGDALPUR :

Raipur to Jagdalpur approximate distance is 300Kms and takes approximately six hours by road. You can also cover this distance by a direct flight from Raipur 's Swami Vivekananda Airport to Jagadalpur 's Maa Danteswari Airport on every Tuesdays and Thursdays.



DONGARGARH : (ONE DAY TOUR)

Dongargarh is the main tourist and pilgrimage destination in Chhattisgarh. Maa Bamleshwari Devi Temple which of a great spiritual importance and the people of Chhattisgarh consider it as a Tirth.



HOW TO REACH DONGARGARH :

The driving distance between Raipur to Dongargarh in 109 kms. It takes approximately 1h 38m to drive from Raipur to Dongargarh. The cheapest way to reach from Raipur to Dongargarh is train and it takes 1h 40m.

MAINPAT : (TWO DAYS TOUR)

Mainpat is a beautiful hill station with green pastures, deep valleys, breathtaking waterfalls, dense forests and untouched rivulets. It is often called as Shimla of Chhattisgarh and Mini Tibet owing to its huge Tibetan population and influence over the area. The Tibetan refugees were rehabilitated in Mainpat after the Chinese invasion of Tibet and have since found a home in Mainpat.



DhakpoShedupling Monastery, Tiger Point, Parpatiya Sunset Point, Jaljali, Mercury Falls, Daroga Jharna are the main tourist attractions. Mainpat is a trekker 's paradise with still a whole lot of places to be discovered. Just go on a trek along the hills and you could chance upon a plethora of waterfalls, ponds and river streams. There are also a host of adventure sports offered at Fish Point and Tiger Point like paragliding, rappelling and rock climbing among others that you could partake in and indulge your inner adrenaline junkie.

HOW TO REACH MAINPAT :

One of the best ways to do a trip, especially the one to a hill station is by taking a road trip. The distance between Raipur and Mainpat is 249 kms which takes around 7 hours. The nearest railway station is Ambikapur over 80 kilometres from Mainpat. There are buses and taxis available from Ambikapur to Mainpat.

NANDAN VAN ZOO & SAFARI : (HALF DAY TOUR)

Nandan Van Zoo, located at Naya Raipur, is one of the famous places of visit in the city. With its primary objective to protect and conserve animals, the zoo has many species of fauna. There are jungle safari and boating rides and is a perfect spot to spend the day. It is fascinating to watch the animals wander around the jungle, and it also gives an exposure to many species which are not very popular and on the verge of extinction. Also, the facilities provided by the zoo are comfortable and affordable.



HOW TO REACH NANDAN VAN :

Nandan Van Zoo at Naya Raipur is located at a distance of 13.5 kilometers from the heart of the city. Local buses, auto and cabs are available to commute to the zoo. Private vehicles or hired ones can be used to reach the zoo.

RAJIM : (HALF DAY TOUR)

Rajim is considered the perfect place to witness Chhattisgarh's rich cultural heritage. Also known as the 'Prayag ' of Chhattisgarh, Rajim is the spot of the union of three holy rivers - Mahanadi (Chitrotpala), Pairi and Sondur. This point of meeting of these three rivers is also referred to as the 'Triveni Sangam' . The Chhattisgarh Kumbh Mela takes place over here from Magh Poonima to Mahashivaratri every year. Rajiv Lochan Temple is dedicated to Lord Vishnu and is regarded as the main attraction of Rajim. Rajim is famous for its various temples and historical monuments. It is home to the Rajiv Lochan Temple, the Rajesvar Temple, Ramachandra Temple, Daneshwar Temple, Jagannath Temple, Kuleshwar Temple, and Champaram among others. The Chhattisgarh Kumbh mela is held from mid-February to March every year, spanning throughout 15 days. This holy event attracts scores of Sadhus, Sants, Mahatmas, Rishis, and Munis from India and abroad. The Rajiv Lochan Mahotsav is an event that is held during the Kumbh Mela festival at Rajim. There is unique music, and dance performances held to display the culture of Chhattisgarh.



How To Reach Rajim :

Rajim is a small town that is at a distance of 45 km from Raipur. Buses, private vehicles or hired ones can be used to reach there.

Chitrakote Falls : (Two Days Tour)

The broadest waterfall in India, Chitrakote is popularly known as the Niagara of India, because

of its width. Situated in the west side of Jagdalpur in the Bastar District of Chhattisgarh, this waterfall originates from the Indravati river. Chitrakote Falls is at the height of about 30 metres with a width of 985 feet, and during monsoons, you can watch the falls at its full glory. The fall cascades from the top of the cliff in 3 streams during summers. A significant attraction below the fall is the shrine of Lord Shiva with many small Shivalingas. During the low season, locals and tourists are seen to be swimming, bathing or even using paddle boats on the river.



How To Reach Chitrakote Falls :

The distance from Raipur to waterfalls is 290 kms which takes six hours of drive and the closest station is the Jagdalpur railway station, you can get a shared taxi or a private taxi from the station up to the falls. The cheapest way to get to the falls are the state-run buses that ply from Jagdalpur to Chitrakote falls, there are around 4-5 buses running every day and take up to 2 hours to cover a distance of 38 kilometres.

Kanha National Park : (Two Days Tour)

Kanha National Park is nestled in the Maikal range of Satpuras in Madhya Pradesh, the heart of India that forms the central Indian highlands. The national park is being popularized as the Tiger reserve and interestingly is being declared as one of the finest wildlife areas in the world. A trip to Kanha Reserve directly takes you to the widespread arena of the lush habitat of wild creatures. With jeep safari an encounter to all these species is really generous and worthwhile. With jungle safari you can take a closer look to the wild animals and can capture their magnanimous images in your cameras.



How to Reach Kanha National Park :

There is no direct connection from Raipur to Kanha National Park. However, you can take the train to Gondia Jn then take the taxi to Kanha National Park. The distance from Raipur to Kanha National Park is approx. 200 kms which takes five hours of drive.

Mata Kaushalya Mandir : (Half Days Tour)

Mata Kaushalya temple is a Hindu temple dedicated to Mata Kaushalya, mother of Lord Ram. It is the only temple in the world dedicated to Mata Kaushalya.[1] It is located at Chandkhuri village around 27km away from Raipur in Chhattisgarh.



In 2020, the Chief minister of Chhattisgarh, Shri Bhupesh Baghel, laid the foundation stone for the expansion of the temple few days before the foundation stone of the Ram temple in Ayodhya was laid.[3] He said that the ancient Mata Kaushalya temple will be given a magnificent look while keeping its original form intact.

Location:

The temple is located around 22km[4] to 27km [2] away from the Capital City Raipur in



Chhattisgarh State. The temple is located in the middle of a lake surrounded by the Chadkhuri village. The temple is accessed by walking on the bridge called Hanuman Pul which has a statue of Hanuman over it.

About:

The temple has the idol of Mata Kaushalya holding Lord Shri Ram in her lap. The temple is believed to have been constructed in the 8th century. The temple had been damaged and rebuilt many times. In 1973, the temple was renovated.



Shree Ram Mandir : (Half Days Tour)

A wonderful temple of Lord ram, with a stunning view and garden around it. Explore Shri Ram Mandir through captivating images that showcase their rich culture, history, and charm. Shri Ram Mandir, Raipur, Chhattisgarh Beautiful structure of the temple and the garden area. There is also a shelter home for the animals. Bhajan sabha, facility for shoe rack, water facility, and many more. It is a beautiful place for every age people.
