

- The webinar was attended by 400+ delegates from all over the country









The first teleconsultation session on Treatment of Cervical Pre-Cancer was successfully rolled out on 7th and 8th April 2021 under the guidance of Department of Health, Department of Medical Education, and leadership at NHM including Dr Ashish Saxena, DD-NCD and Dr Archana Mishra, DD-MH. The sessions were conducted in two batches covering **34 participants** (Gynaecologists, PGMOs and female medical officers) from 12 facilities. Batch 1 was led by Dr Smita Joshi, Prayas and HCJMRI, Pune, while Dr. Saritha Shamsunder, President ISCCP mentored batch 2. During the session participants were oriented on the WHO recommended screening and treatment algorithm and management of VIA positive women. Participants from district hospital and medical colleges presented case studies, highlighting their experience of the treatment and also shared discussed on improving the availability and accessibility of the treatment. Similar sessions will be planned further enabling knowledge enhancement and exchange of ideas among the service providers engaged in treatment of CIN. From the Editor's Pen

Greetings from ISCCP and a Healthy life to all,

The rapidly expanding COVID-19 pandemic has impacted all areas of daily life, including medical care. The primary intervention to slow the disease are physical distancing, hand hygiene, use of mask for respiratory hygiene, and staying home as much as possible. These interventions are affecting the psychosocial health in general population and affecting the recovery of already ill patients as well. Appropriate care to cancer patients during this pandemic is challenging and the of death from cancer versus death or serious complications from SARS-CoV-2, and the likely higher lethality of COVID-19 in immunocompromised hosts is to be carefully balanced. Other challenges which we all are facing comprise of cancellations of in-hospital visits; delays in routine cancer screening leading to significant declines in the number of patients with newly identified cancers during the pandemic and surgery postponements or cancellations. There is no "one size fits all" approach to delivering cancer care during the COVID-19 pandemic, and no international guidelines.

Treatment decisions must be made on a case-by-case basis. Although in the






