- It was aimed to increase the training centers
 - 40 colposcopy trainers
 - 34 accredited centers across the country has been established (previously 9 centres)

It is now easy for a trainee to choose the trainer close to his or her working place







Colposcopy Training


Twenty-seven trainees enrolled in the first batch from 12 centers.

- Online Theory Classes for colposcopy trainees were conducted every Thursday since 8 Dec 2022 for 16 weeks followed by 3 revision classes. (To Maintain Uniformity of teaching)
- Candidiates who have successufly submitted logbook endorsed by accredited trainers were eligible for Qualifying exam
- Qualifying exam was held on 20th and 21st April 2023.
 - 15 students appeared for the exam and 11 qualified.




- The talks are followed by felicitations of 9 ISCCP members across India in recognition of their service for cervical cancer elimination.
