
Annual GBM, EC and Other Committees meetings

- 5. Members: Current membership strength is 865





Training Activities


- Second Train the Trainer Program: 4th June 2023: 20 new trainers are accredited taking the trainers strength to 60 Pan India


















18th IFCPC World Congress

Activities from West: Dr Bharthi Abhyankar

- AJARA, a village in Gadhinglaj Taluk: 58 female workers in spinning mill were screened for cervical (LBC+VIA) and breast cancer.
- A very remote village in NESARY Taluk: 29 women had LBC, one had ASC-H was selected
- SANGAV, village near Kolhapur: 25 women for screened with LBC and VIA
- Planned to screen all the volunteers in NGO SWAYAMSIDDHA. There are 6 to 8 thousand women to be screened




