


ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR COMPETITION PAPERS:

- * All the details of the candidate, Co-authors institute should be in the cover letter accompanying the main manuscript and NOT in the title page or main manuscript
- * The candidate should be a member of ISCCP (mention the membership number) and <u>candidate should</u> be less than 35 years of <u>age(enclose age proof)</u>
- * Registration for Conference is Mandatory and the registration number of the conference is to be enclosed
- * Submit competition Papers (abstract & full text) by email
- * The Research should be original and should not have been already published
- * Best 7 papers will be selected as competition papers by a panel of judges. The winners are allowed to present their papers in the main conference

Each winner will receive a grant money of 15,000 rupees
