Colposcopy course and hands-on workshop was organized on 28th and 29th August, 2013 by the Department of Minimal and Natural Access Gynae & Gynae Cancer Surgery Fortis Vasant Kunj and Fortis Memorial Research institute, Gurgaon at Fortis Memorial Research Institute, Gurgaon.
